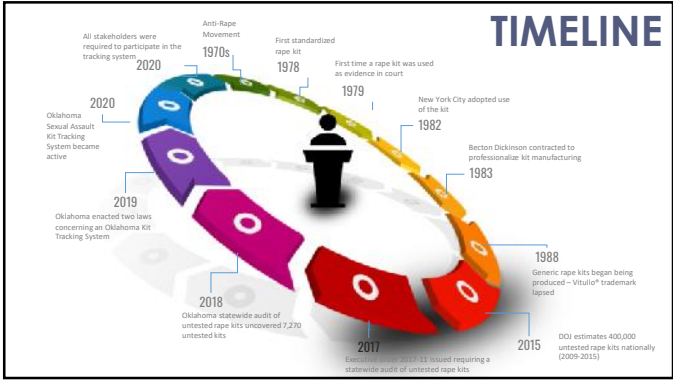

THE FIRST SEXUAL ASSAULT EVIDENCE COLLECTION KIT

01 Louis R. Vitullo is frequently credited as the developer of the first kit, it was originally researched and proposed to Vitullo by Martha 'Marty' Goddard, who was a victim advocate and founder of Chicago's Citizens for Victims Assistance organization, and herself a sexual assault survivor

02 Examinations are performed by medical professionals, most commonly physicians and sexual assault nurse examiners (SANEs)



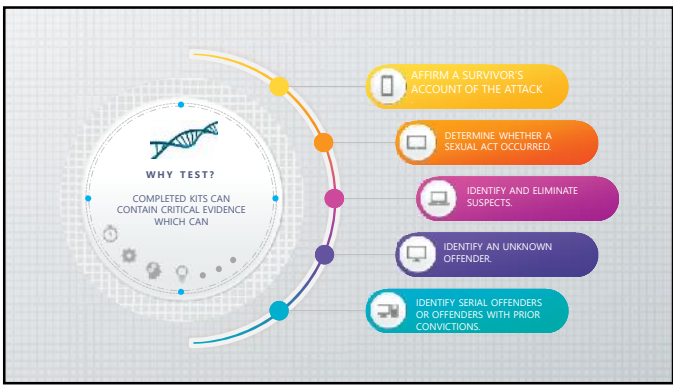

<p>1 Standardized Kits Distribution of same standardized sexual assault evidence kits.</p>	<p>4 50 Year Rule Collected kits, tested or untested, must be retained in a secure, environmentally safe manner for not less than 50 years or for the length of the statute of limitations for the alleged crime, whichever is longer.</p>
<p>2 20 Day Rule Requires law enforcement to submit sexual assault evidence kits to a crime lab for testing within 20 days of receiving the evidence unless the victim requests that the kit not be tested.</p>	<p>5 Kit Storage Each law enforcement agency is responsible for the maintenance and storage of untested kits either in their own evidence storage or through an agreement with another agency with larger capacity.</p>
<p>3 Informing Victim in Writing At the time the SANE exam, a report of the sexual assault is not made or if the victim requests that kit not be tested, the medical provider shall inform the victim in writing of his or her right to request the testing of the sexual assault evidence kit at any future time.</p>	

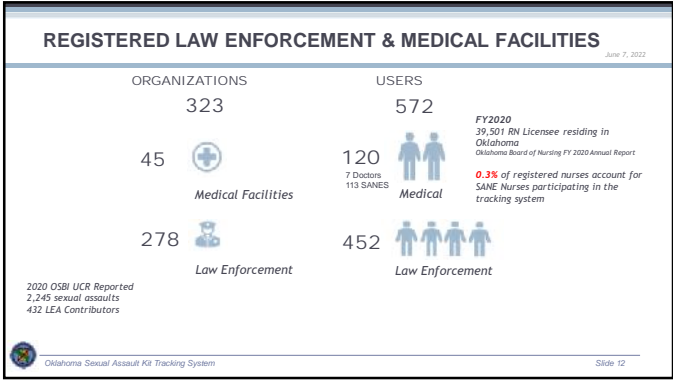


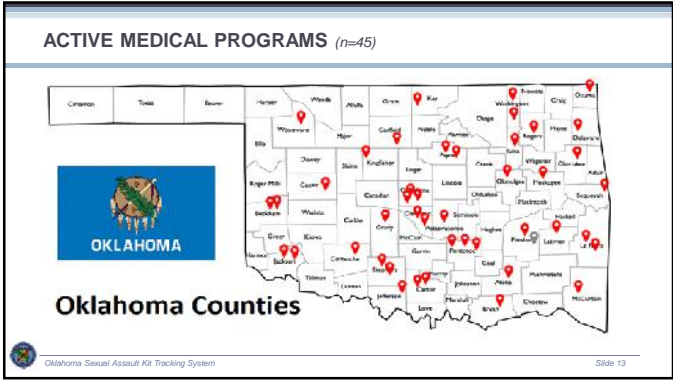


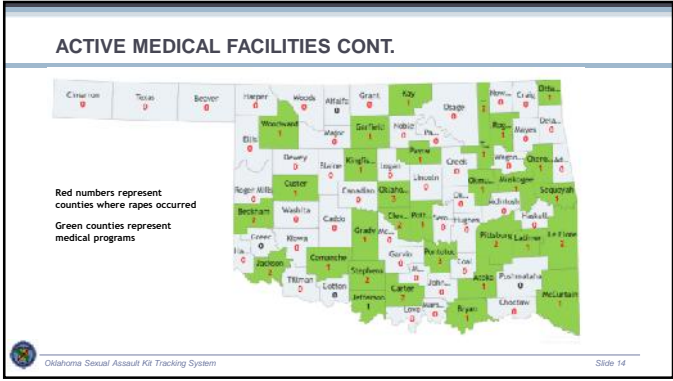

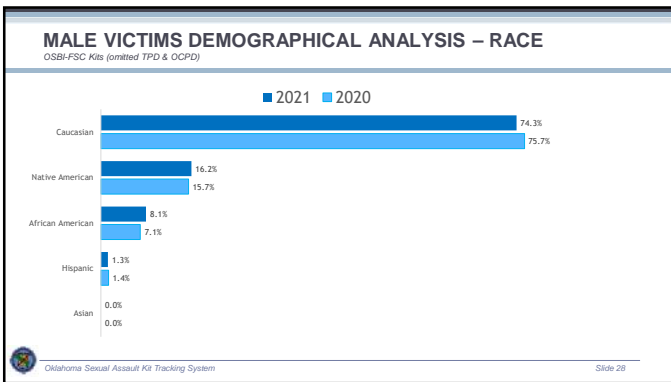


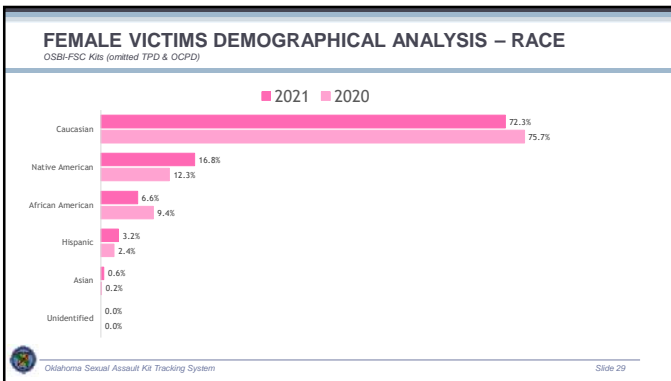


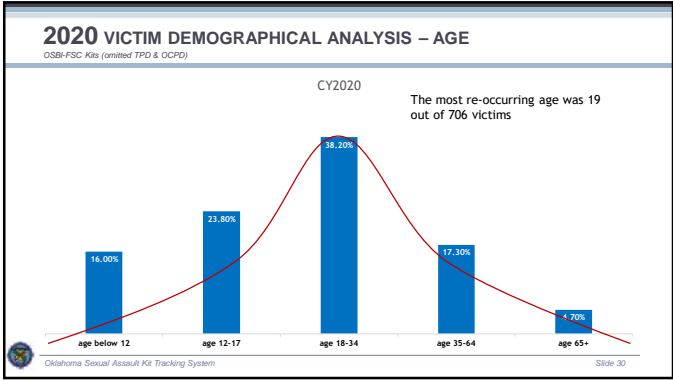


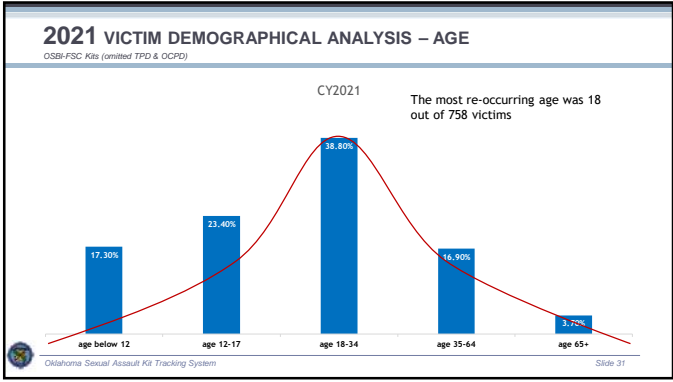


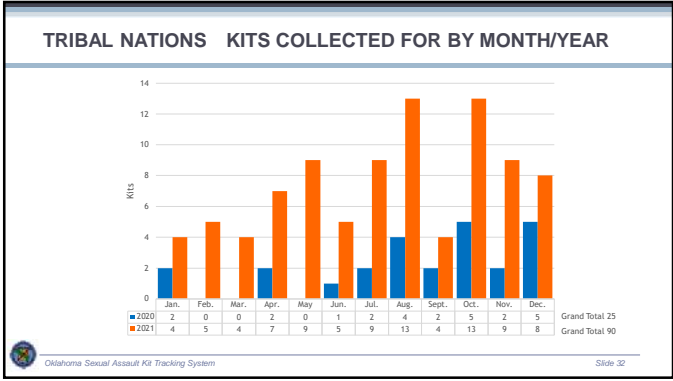


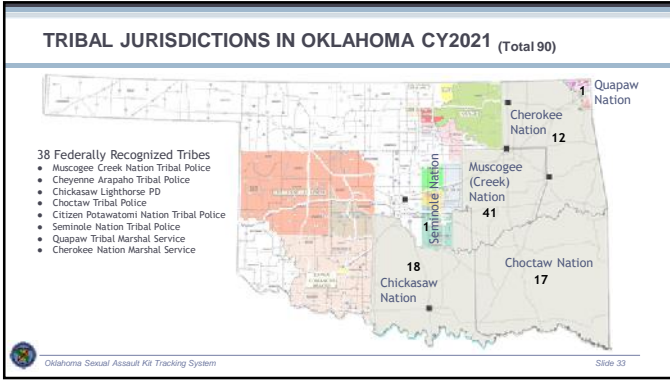


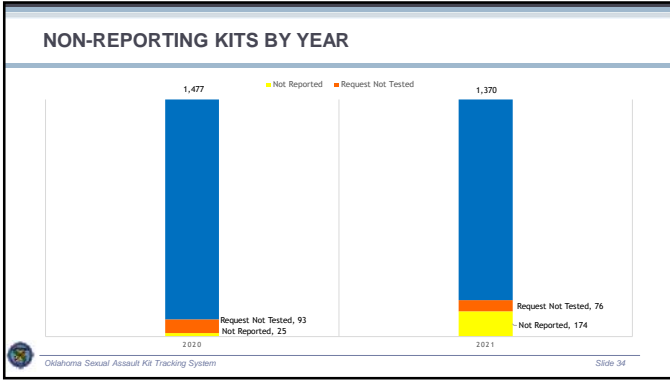












SEXUAL ASSAULT KIT TRACKING SYSTEM (SAKTS)

This system is web-based and can be accessed from anywhere with an internet connection and is compatible with most mobile devices

Each type of organization will have unique views (lab, law enforcement agency, and medical facility)

Sexual assault victims will be able to track their kits by the kit tracking number (the public view will give limited details such as date, status and location of kit)

Authorizing Legislation

This website enables the tracking of sexual assault evidence kits* in the State of Oklahoma in compliance with Oklahoma Statute Title 14, Section 1502.234.

*Sexual assault evidence kits consist of evidence, such as swabs and items for forensic DNA analysis, such as coffee filters, evidence from a victim's reported sexual assault and the evidence preserved with such remains.

Instructions

Victims of sexual assault can view the history and current status of their sexual assault evidence kit by entering the sexual assault evidence kit tracking # in the "Serial number" box above and clicking the adjacent search button with the magnifying glass icon.

Authorized medical, law enforcement, county prosecutor, and lab personnel should select "Login" and enter their unique username and password to manage the status of sexual assault evidence kits under the jurisdiction of their agency.

- 01 SA kit sent to Medical Facility for use

CHALLENGES

- Employee Attrition Notification**
 Oftentimes organizations forget to notify the tracking Administrator when a staff member leaves, so the administrator is not aware that a new person may need to be trained on and added to the tracking system.
- Responding to Receiving/Send Kits**
 Some medical facilities are not punctual on receiving new unused kits at their facilities and/or will send the physical kit to the law enforcement agency in a timely many, but fail to document the action in the tracking system.
- Lost or Misplaced Kits**
 Law enforcement agencies are occasionally losing track of a physical kit associated with a sexual assault. This may partly be associated with employee attrition. For example, employees retire, resign, terminated, or simply aren't replaced.
- Federal Gov. & Tribal Nations**
 There is no statutory requirement for the federal government and Tribal Nations to use the tracking system. This has affected the accuracy of the kit location and inaccurate data. I continue to work through this issue with cooperating federal and tribal agencies.

CHALLENGES

- Poor Access to Forensic Medical Examiners**
 A lack of sufficient medical facilities has forced law enforcement agencies to seek assistance from medical providers outside of Oklahoma.
- Non-reporting Kits**
 When non-reporting (anonymous) kits are collected by the medical provider they will notify a larger agency to pick the kits up. However, the non-reporting kit has no report and the LEA is unaware that they need to notify the jurisdiction were the incident occurred so the kit can be picked up. If the victim decides to have their kit tested then it becomes a challenge to locate it.
